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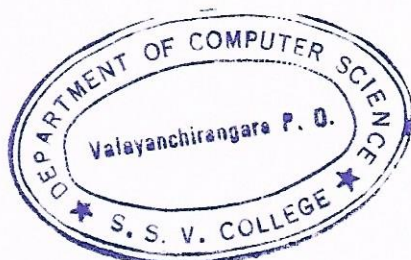

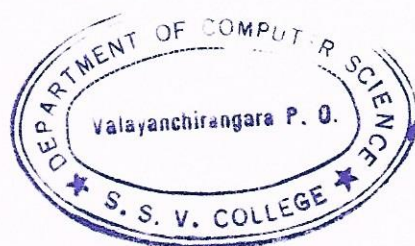

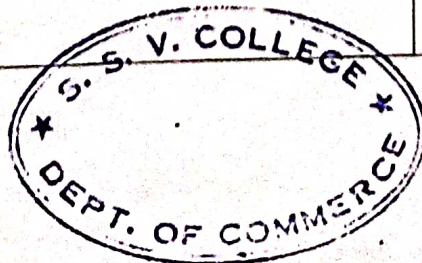

Our department focused on providing constructive suggestions for curriculum development and enhancing the overall academic ambience, including infrastructure and facilities.

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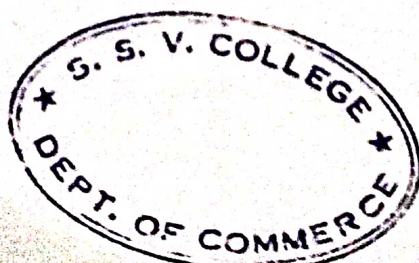

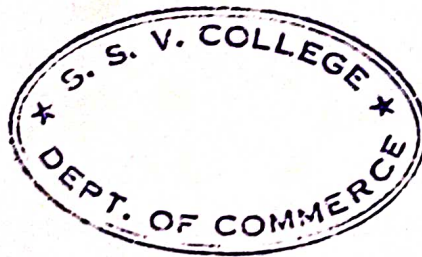

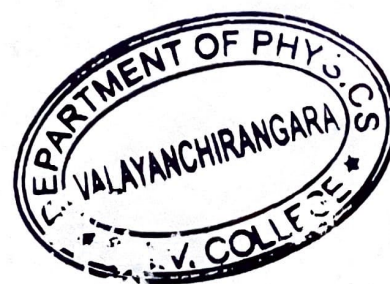
