MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ON EXCHANGE OF STUDENTS/STAFF/FACULTY

Between

St. Teresa's College (Autonomous), Ernakulam, Kerala, India

&

Sree Sankara Vidyapeetom College, Sreesankarapuram, Perumbavoor, Kerala, India

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) has come into existence on 8th August, 2022, to establish an affiliation between Department of History, St Teresa's College, and Ernakulam (hereinafter also referred to as "the first party")

and

Post Graduate Department of History, Sree Sankara Vidyapeetom College, Sreesankarapuram, Perumbavoor (hereinafter also referred to as "the second party")

NOW THEREFORE THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITNESSES AS FOLLOWS:

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as hereinafter refer to as "MoU") is a non-exclusive agreement for collaboration between the first party and the second party (hereinafter also referred to as "both parties").

This MoU is valid for a period of One year, from the date of this document, and maybe extended further on mutual consent.

Both parties will designate a contact person from each side who will be the primary point of contact on behalf of that party, the contact details of each of whom will be provided in writing to both parties.

Preamble

Whereas both parties have many areas of common interest in arts, science and commerce, considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit on a collaborative basis in the fields of academics, education and research.

Now therefore, both parties have decided to enter into this MoU, which defines the framework for the cooperation of the two institutions set out in the following sections.

Objectives

The parties agree that the objective of the present MoU is to establish of the cooperation programme in order to collaborate towards the formation of students, academics and researchers, for the promotion and development of their respective areas of interests.

Areas of Cooperation

Both Institutes agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity.

The two institutions shall seek to promote:

- The exchange of faculty to the mutual benefit of both institutions,
- Collaboration in teaching, research and consultancy studies in the field of mutual interest,
- The exchange of academic materials and publications,
- Conducting lectures,
- Attachment of staff for purposes of curriculum development and review, attendance of courses, upgrading of teaching and research skills,
- Participating in seminars, symposiums, and other types of academic discussions,

A specific plan will be worked out for each activity; setting forth detailed arrangements for collaboration will be agreed. Terms and conditions for each visit or an assignment or such exchange, will be worked out between the institutes.


Funding

Expenses for transportation, room and board and personal expenses of exchange of students and teachers shall be covered by each individual.

No Employment Relationship

Both parties agree that this Agreement shall not be construed in any manner as establishing any kind of partnership or bond of a labour nature between them. Thus, in all activities stemming from the present MoU and from subsequent action plans, both parties are in the understanding that, in all cases, no employment relationship shall remain in force between the employing institution and the respective personnel.

Autonomy

This agreement is a statement of intentions and does not involve, in any instance whatsoever, any financial obligations between the subscribing institutions.

Conflict Resolution

Any dispute resulting from the interpretation or application of this Agreement shall be settled through direct negotiation and common agreement by the persons delegated to such end by each Institution. Either party may propose to the other a modification of the Agreement at any time in writing.

Confidentiality

Each of the parties accepts and declares that every information from the other party is of a confidential nature, is an exclusive property of the latter, and has been or will be disclosed to the former solely with the purpose of enabling the full accomplishment of the present Agreement. For this reason, every piece of information provided by one party to the other before signing this Agreement and/or during its performance must be kept confidential and therefore may not be disclosed to any third parties.

Amendments

The parties may amend or amplify this Agreement through agreements in writing to that effect. Said amendments or additions will be binding on the signatories as of the date of the signature. The parties may not assign, a whole, or in part, the performance of the present MoU to any third party, except through prior and express authorization in writing by both of them.

And since both parties are in agreement, regarding the content of the present document, and as a token of conformity, we sign it in two counterparts, both of which will be considered originals.
