### **Divyangjan Facilities**

The infrastructural facilities of College is Divyangjanfriendly in order to make the study environment more convenient for the differently abled students. The college has following facilities:

### **Canteen Facilities**

The College canteen is one of the liveliest areas of the campus. Our canteen aims at providing a variety of quality food at reasonable rates. The college canteen operates on a healthy eating policy and no fizzy drinks are permitted. It is open from 8.30 in the morning till 5 pm in the evening. The overall administration of the Canteen is under the supervision of a Canteen Committee drawn by the College Staff Council.

### **Labs**

The college has several labs in various departments as part of curriculum. It includes language lab and labs of Computer science, Physics and Chemistry.

#### **Language lab**

Language Lab has a user friendly multi lingual learning software installed to enhance the communicative efficiency of students. It is supervised by the department of English. It provides short term course on spoken English.

#### **Computer lab**

Computer lab with 30 computers connected to the campus network is maintained by the Computer Science Department . Broadband WiFi connectivity is provided to faculty members.

### **Physics lab**

Physics lab is well equipped to provide an experimental foundation for the theoretical concepts included in the syllabus. Students are guided with basic and advanced knowledge of general experimental techniques in the area of Physics. The laboratories of the Physics department include computer laboratory and separate laboratories for Physics students and for the students who have taken Mathematics and Chemistry as their main subject.

### **Chemistry lab**

Chemistry department has two well-equipped laboratories with all facilities required for graduate and PG courses. Labs give students the opportunity to perform experiments that explore important chemical concepts and introduce proper lab techniques and safety. The students will demonstrate the ability to solve chemical problems using logical procedures based on well-established scientific principles.

### **Yoga Centre**

The College Yoga Centre provides Yoga classes for the students and staff of the college. Yoga helps to improve breathing, lessen stress, enhance metabolism and keep diseases away.

### **Health Club**

Health Club of the college is armed with top class fitness equipment. Both students and staff of the college avail the facilities. Trainers are present to provide advice and support. It is under the supervision of the department of Physical education.

### **Hostel**

Our college provides hostel facility to the girls. Hostel is situated in the premise of the college, in a very calm and quiet surroundings. The hostel is managed by a committee selected from the teaching staff with the Principal as the Chief Warden for the close supervision and guidance. A full time Assistant warden is also provided to ensure the smooth functioning of the hostel. The application to the hostel is given on the day of the admission itself.

## **Heritage museum**

Heritage Museum is really a mark of the Department of History. It has been functioning in the College for the two decades. It consists of archaeological remains, relics, products of workmanship, coins, kitchen vessels etc used by the people in ancient societies in the neighborhood. It contains 61 different items of which Numismatics, Charts which deal with the history of Numismatics, wooden utensils, manuscripts and copper plates need special mention. With the participation of the students, excavations were conducted at different places of archaeological importance and archaeological remains which were dugout from these areas are collected, classified and demonstrated in the Museum. It helps us to talk with the people who lived in a particular period and to understand the way of life and cultural life of those people. We have coins of different countries, and models of relics used by the Harappan people who lived before the Christian era. A lot of Manuscripts and agricultural tools and implements are also included. It really creates great enthusiasm among students to know our early ancestors and their cultural heritage. With great pleasure we keep our museum open to all the students in the College and they visit the museum with great curiosity. We conduct Exhibitions as a part of our History day celebrations and provide opportunities for all to visit our museum. As an extension activity we arranged an Exhibition at Mannam Vidyabhavan English Medium School, Valayanchirangara. Students from different schools visited and this was an event of wide approval and appreciation from the public. We adopt modern scientific techniques to preserve the remains for posterity.

## **Library**

The library is considered as the heart of all higher education institutions. It is an essential prerequisite for successful implementation of higher education programmes. The college has a well equipped library. There is a library advisory committee to oversee the functioning of the library. The library has a total collection of about 26000 books including reference titles. The library subscribes more than 15 periodicals and 9 dailies including 3 national dailies and 6 regional dailies. The library has initiated the subscription process of 15 printed journals according to the suggestions from different departments. A collection of cds are also available for reference usage.

## **Services and Facilities**

### **Lending of Books**

Four books are issued to post graduate students and two books are issued to degree students for a period of 14 days. There is a provision for renewal of books after 14 days. Teachers can take books as per their need and books should be returned back before the end of the academic year.

### **Open Access Library**

Open access system is being practiced in the library and users have direct access to the library resources.

### **Reference Books**

About 1400 books are kept for reference use within the library

### **Reference Service**

Assistance is provided for locating specific pieces of information by the library staff.

### **Internet Service**

Internet browsing facility is being provided for to our students and faculty members free of cost.

### **NList Service**

E journals and e books through n list portal are available for students and teachers.

### **Print Journal Service**

Library has initiated the process for subscription of 15 print journals from different subject fields

### **Library Automation**

The college library is automated using OCSCA/ENLIGHT software. facility is provided. Issue, return, renewal, fine collection etc are done with the help of the software.
