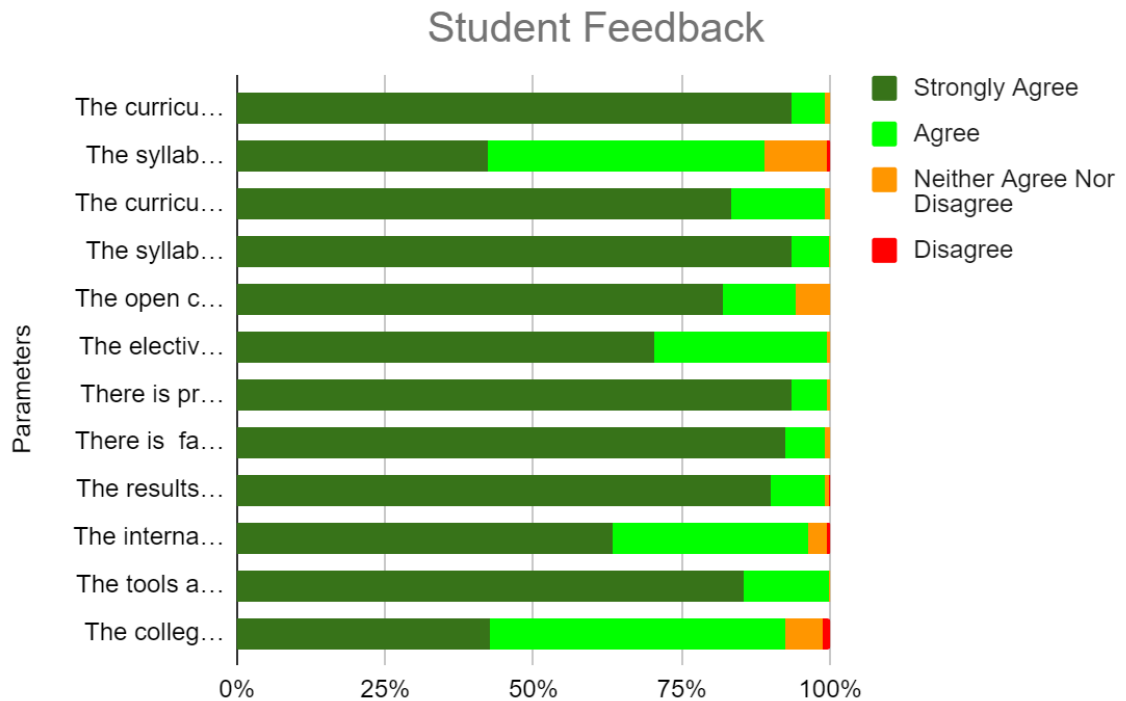

Overall, the feedback indicates the concerns about the online classes. Below is a summary of the feedback received for each statement:



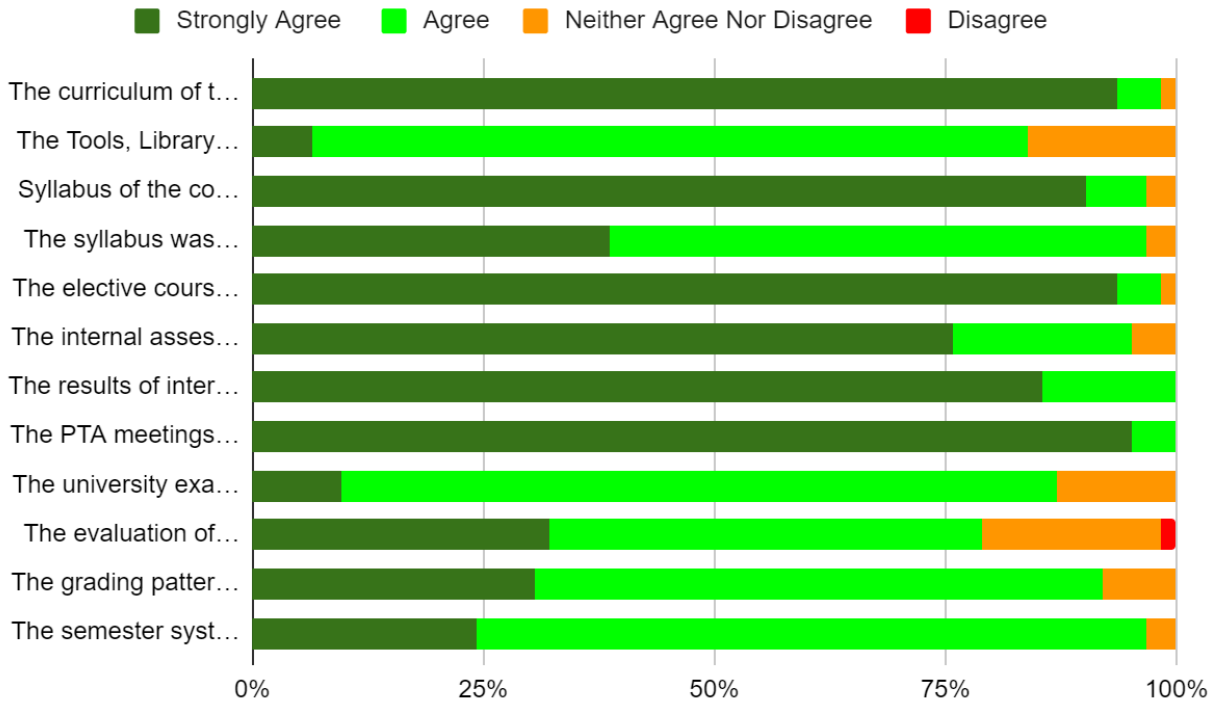
Major suggestions from students

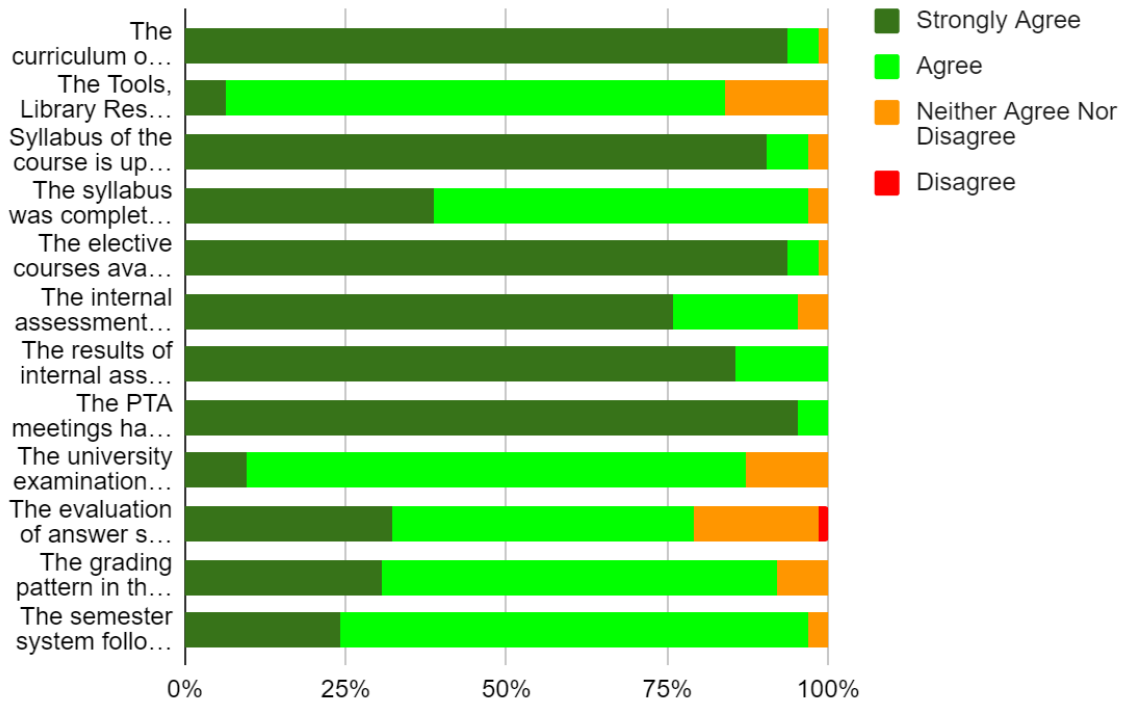


Major suggestions from Teachers

Parent Feedback Analysis Report 2019-2020

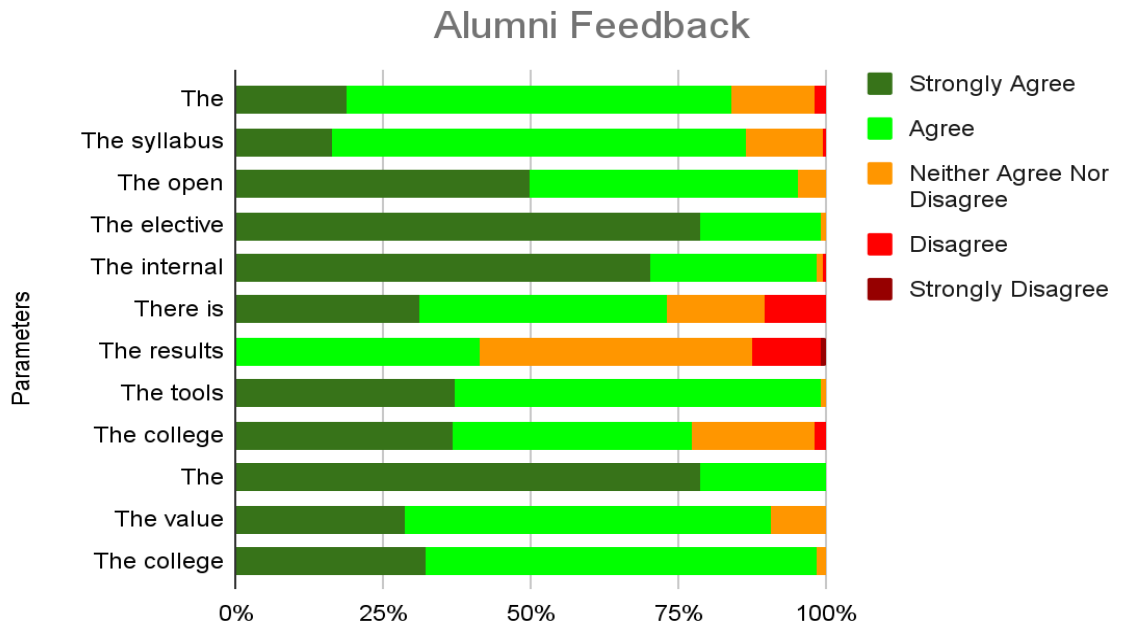


Major Comments and Suggestions by parents

Alumni Feedback Analysis Report 2019-2020

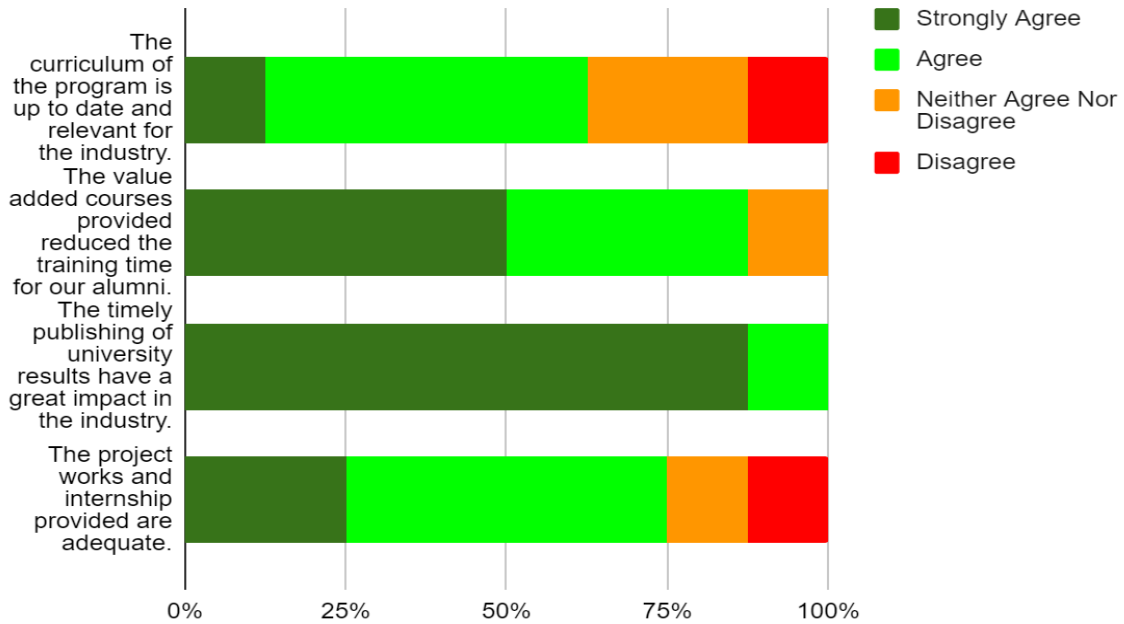


Major Suggestions by Alumni
