Session II: Start-up Journey Issues and Challenges



He is the Technical Officer (IPR) of National Biodiversity Authority, Govt. of India. Dr. Narendran explained the role and relevance of IPR in today's world.


2nd November 2020

Motivational Session by a successful entrepreneur.



A Counselling session on Innovation and Entrepreneurship



Mr. Unnikrishnan the founder of Garga M Commerce Limited was the speaker of the session. 30 students and 3 faculty members attended the session.


29th May 2021


