About the Institution

Sree Sankara Vidyapeetom College, founded five decades ago and named after Sree Sankaracharya, the great visionary, is situated in Irapuram, a remote serene village about 30 kilometers from the sprawling city of cochin. The proximity of Kaladi, the birth place of Adi Sankara, cast a spiritual bearing over the very concept of this situation. Away from towns and traffic-ridden highways, our campus boasts of a perfect learning atmosphere. Set in an environmental bliss, the College has a campus stretching into 18 acres of prime land in these sylvan plain.



The college is managed by The SREE SANKARA TRUST, which was formed in 1965, for promoting higher education in conformity with the ideals propagated by the great saint. The trust is owned and managed by Nambuthiris, the traditional Brahmins of Kerala, known as Keraladwijas in Sanskrit. Authentic history reveals that the Namboothiris, in addition to their Vedic duties, were traditional scholars and teachers. Namboothiri houses in any villages in Kerala were virtual centers of learning where knowledge in fields such as Airbed, Astrology, Architecture, ethics and Mathematics were imparted in gurukula system. Several books on these subjects, authored by Nambuthiris, are still considered and followed as root sources of information in these disciplines. Written on palm leaves, many of these basic works are still preserved at the manuscripts library in Trivandrum. It might have been this tradition which prompted our pioneers to think in terms of floating a trust to

promote higher education in the name of Adi Sankara, who himself was a great teacher.

Being social workers at the grass root level, the founders of the trust, headed by Sri. P.N. Namboodiri, a life long worker of Bharat Sevak Samaj, was importunate in selecting underdeveloped and educationally backward rural areas to launch their institutions. The two other colleges of the Trust are also isolated, far-flung rural areas of Kerala. These points to the commitment of our founders to the cause of rural upliftment.

Thirty five years back, Irapuram was a God-forsaken village of small-time peasants and agricultural labourerstoiling hard for a meager sustenance. Any sort of developmental projects worth its name were unheard of. The absolute lack of commuting facilities made institutions of higher education practically inaccessible to this rural folk. The beginning of Sree Sankara Vidyapeetom College at Irapuram marked a radical improvement in higher education and at the same time prompted a social awakening of multilateral aspects. Thirty-five years after now, though the region remains still industrially and economically stagnant, the presence of the College renders it an ethos of modern times.

History / Milestones



Founder P.N Namboodiri, Thiruvalla

Sri. P.N. Namboothiri was born in 1917 at Peringaragrama, a village near Thiruvalla in Pathanamthitta Dist. of Kerala. Sri. P.N devoted his whole life for the upliftment of the society was a well-known Gandhian and freedom fighter. He served as the president of

PeringaragramaPanchayath and as a member of Thiruvalla municipal council. He was a lifelong member and chairman of the BharathSevakSamajam, Kerala chapter.

The only factor behind the establishment of Sree Sankara Vidhyapeetom College, Valayanchirangara was the far sightedness and efficient leadership of Sri. P.N. As he understood the necessity of the presence of the Namboothiri community in the field of education, he founded the Sree Sankara Trust. Today the trust has three colleges, schools and several other cultural institutions. Sri. P.N who had been the secretary and chairman of the trust on several occasions was also its lifelong patron and active member.

The new leadership of the trust is moving towards the fulfillment of the dreams P.N had. Sri. P.N wanted to have a hospital, a vocational trading centre and an old age home under the leadership of the trust.

The trust had published a book in memory of Sri. P.N. Namboothiri in the name "Thilodakam". Sri. P.N. Namboothiri who devoted his whole life as spokesman for the values of our nation and humanity and mankind is our inspiration... 'Pranams' at your feet, Gurudev.

- 2.Online quiz programme on the topic "Energy Consumption" was held in the month of May 2020 and e- certificate was provided for those who acquired above 60% marks.









4. CHEM ONAM CELEBRATION -2020



5. OZONE DAY CELEBRATIONS 2020




ALUMNI ASSOCIATION ACTIVITIES



WOMEN'S FORUM –ACTIVITIES 2020-2021



RTI

The Right To Information Act 2005 was passed by the parliament on 15th June 2005. The Act mandates that organizations defined as "Public Authorities" are obliged to provide information to the public and create necessary arrangements in order to promote transparency and accountability in the working of every public authority.

The Right to Information Act, 2005 (22 of 2005) has been enacted by the Parliament and has come into force from 15 June, 2005. This Act provides for right to information for citizens to secure access to information under the control of public authorities in order to promote transparency and accountability in the working of every public authority. All Universities and Colleges established by law made by Parliament or by State Legislature or by notification by the appropriate Government or owned, controlled or substantially financed directly or indirectly by funds provided by the Government shall come within the meaning of a Public Authority under this Act.

Whereas, some provisions of this act have come into effect immediately on its enactment (that is on 15 June 2005), other provisions shall come into effect on 100 / 120 days of its enactment.

2.3.1

The college has adopted several student centric programmes for the holistic development of students. Students make active participation in seminars, debates, quizzes, competitions and enhance their experiences.

- 16. Language lab
- 17. Fairs and exhibitions
- 18. Internships
- 19. Case study method

Each department implements different learning techniques including problem -based enquiries, project -based enquiries, case study based enquiries and technology -based enquiries. Also, most of the departments have conducted skill development webinars and workshops to enable students to acquire a skill which can help them to become financially independent. Students are also provided proper guidance to learn about issues in the contemporary times, such as floods, the pandemic, environmental issues etc.

Student centric Problem Solving Methods

Students have to submit

Co- Scholastic Learning Activities

According to varied interests of students, they can participate in co-curricular activities, skill development activities, art festivals, creative competitions, problem solving competitions, field visits, games, sports etc.

OPPORTUNITIES TO CONTRIBUTE TO THE SOCIETY

Apart from these activities, students are also made responsible for organizing webinars, academic and cultural programmes and workshops. They are given simple problems or questions to clarify concepts. The teachers help students not only to score good marks, but also mold them into leaders. Students are also encouraged to work on magazines of various departments. To make them socially responsible, they were motivated to involve in rescue operations and volunteering activities during the floods of 2018 and 2019, and during the Covid 19 pandemic, as part of Youth Red Cross Society, NSS and Kerala Voluntary Youth Action Force (KVYAF). The students receive practical experiences to solve problems, develop skills as well as to emerge as future leaders.

2.3.2

The college has several ICT enabled classes in most of the departments. These classes have projectors and the entire campus has high speed wifi internet connection. To enhance the teaching learning process, the faculties use ICT enabled tools for teaching as well as interacting with students. The department of computer science is keen in providing periodic training programmes to the faculty for effective usage of ICT resources.

The following tools are used by teachers:

- 1. Desktop computers are arranged in all departments and college office
- 2. Printers are installed in departments and college office
- **3.** Photocopier machine is available in the college library
- **4.** Scanners are available along with printers in all departments
- **5.** There is a seminar room equipped with digital facilities
- **6.** Smart Boards and Smart Projectors are made available in the campus for better delivery of curriculum both online and offline
- **7.** Online classes through Zoom, Google Classroom, Google Meet, WhatsApp and Telegram
- **8.** Digital Library facility is made available using N-LIST and DSpace together with Google Classroom is used to provide resources to the students.

Use of ICT by Faculties:

- 1. All teachers use GSuite to manage classes. Teachers post audio lectures, reading materials, Powerpoint presentations, test papers, assignments, and quizzes on the Google Classroom page set for each paper.
- 2. Teachers use Google Meet and Zoom applications for live classes and interactions.
- 3. Google Calendar is used to schedule classes and webinars.
- **4.** Google Slides are also used to create PowerPoint presentations.
- **5.** Google Forms is used to create quizzes and assignments.
- **6.** Google Jamboard is used as an online board where the teacher can write, draw etc during live sessions.
- 7. To improve effectiveness of classes, teachers use pictures, tables and animations in PPTs.
- **8.** Audio lectures, reading materials, notes, programme notices etc are shared through WhatsApp and Telegram.
- **9.** Students are trained in problem solving skills through online platforms. Webinars and workshops on skill development are organized by various departments through Google Meet and Zoom applications.
- 10. Faculties also use Google Meet, Google Forms etc to conduct webinars and competitions

3.2.1

Recognising the necessity of fostering innovation and entrepreneurship among student community and to kindle the entrepreneur skills of students, Sree Sankara Vidyapeetom College has started several initiatives.

Institution's Innovation Council (IIC) registered under the Ministry of Education (MoE), Government of India was established in the year 2018 in our college. From inception itself IIC of our college has organised various activities prescribed by MoE to inculcate the ideas of innovation and entrepreneurship among faculty and students. The major activities conducted in this regard by IIC include

- Seminars and workshops on topics such as Entrepreneurship Development Skills, Entrepreneurship and Innovation as Career Opportunity, National Innovation and Start-up Policy, entrepreneurial development, Start-ups, Intellectual property rights, patent filing.
- Interactive sessions/mentoring sessions with Innovation and Start-up Ecosystem Enablers, Start-up Founders.
- Impact lecture series on the topics Start-up: Ideas, Opportunities and Funding, Start-up Journey Issues and Challenges.

- Motivational talks with successful women entrepreneurs and start-up founders.
- Orientation sessions by Institution Innovation Cell ambassadors for faculties and students.
- Orientation session by Kerala Start-up mission on **Start-up Eco System**, **Business Incubation**, **Patent Support Scheme and Interventions**.
- Field visit to Kerala Start-up Mission, Kerala Technology Innovation Zone, Kinfra, Kalamassery, Ambadimala Water Supply Project of Chottanikkara Panchayath, Ernakulum, Milma, Ernakulam

Apart from the self-driven activities, faculties and students of the college have actively participated in MIC driven activities such as leader ship talks, KAPILA: Kalam Program for IP Literacy and Awareness, Toy—Hackathon.

Institution Innovation Council of Sree Sankara Vidyapeetom College has bagged 3 star rating in the IIC 1.0 period (2018-2019) and was the only Arts and Science College in Kerala to receive 3 star rating in IIC 1.0 evaluation period. The same star rating was maintained in the IIC 2.0 period (2019-2020) and in the academic year 2020-2021, IIC 3.0 period our college has secured 3.5 star rating (the highest grade awarded being 4.0). Three faculties of IIC have successfully completed basic level Innovation Ambassador training Programme and one faculty has completed advanced level Innovation Ambassador training Programme and currently four faculty members of IIC serve as Innovation Ambassadors to mentor students and faculty in the areas of innovation and entrepreneurship

Entrepreneurship Development Club (EDC) was officially formed with the registration and recognition of District Industrial Centre, Ernakulum on 07/04/2016. The ED club of our college has organised exhibitions, Onam and Christmas fairs which has provided a platform for students to recognise and present their marketing skills. Training programmes on bag making, chekkutty doll making, paper files, and seed pen were conducted by EDC in association with District Industrial Centre, Kunnathunad.

Innovation and Entrepreneurship Development Centre (IEDC) was registered under Kerala Start-up Mission and started functioning in our college from 20/11/2020 with the objective of providing opportunities to students and faculties to collaborate, transforming ideas to viable products and also for setting up incubation centre in our college. The IEDC of our college has 254 student members and 2 students of our college has participated in the Innovation Catalyst workshop organised by Kerala Start –up mission.

<u>3.4.1</u>

The students of the college engage in societal issues, and organize street plays, rallies and webinars. They took part in activities related to Health and hygiene, Gender sensitization, emergencies, environmental consciousness and values. Various commemorative days, weeks and fortnights were celebrated because it increases awareness of students towards society. Extension activities during COVID pandemic is being carried out online through webinars for all stakeholders, encompassing diverse social topics. They have made students more aware and

responsible. Students have participated in the webinars by planning and anchoring, adding to their holistic development.

NSS volunteers organized 'plant a tree challenge', and planted trees at their home as a part of the environmental day celebration. In collaboration with Youth Red Cross society the SSV college volunteers undertook the sanitization work at college. Thousand masks were prepared and distributed as a part of 'Kaithaangh' programme.

NSS volunteers conducted online quiz on Hiroshima Nagasaki day on 6th august 2020. To create an awareness among students on Aids, an AIDS Day awareness program was organized on December 1st 2020. NSS Volunteers celebrated and organized Independence day, teacher's day, National Unity day, and National legal service day.

The students are coming up with new ideas and ways to reach out to the community. The college gives them every opportunity to explore all ways of helping the community.

4.2.1

Sree Sankara Vidyapeetom College Library initiated its function since the very inception of Sree Sankara Vidyapeetom College in 1967. The library has a collection of above 25700 books ,15 print journal subscriptions, about 15 periodicals and e resources through N List. The library is attached with Sree Sankara Cultural Study Centre consisting of the collection based on Sree Sankara Acharya And his philosophy. It is also provided with Rare book Collections and competitive exam preparatory collections. The library became computerized in 2008 with Grandhasoft software and later in 2012 the software was changed to Ocsca version 1. First updation was done in 2015 and since then Ocsca version 2 was being used. Now in 2021 the third version Enlight 3 is being used which is fully automated. All the books are bar coded which facilitates fast services. The library provides reprographic facilities, reference services, Network Resource Centre Services, issue-return services etc and hence makes sincere efforts to serve the user community.

5.3.2

Students have representatives in various academic and administrative bodies of the college. There are student representatives in the IQAC in order to ensure the proper functioning of the body for the betterment of the students too. The college union is responsible for conducting and coordinating events like union inauguration, Arts day, and Annual athletic meet. Student representation is also there in various statutory and non-statutory bodies like SC/ST monitoring cell, Anti ragging cell, Antinarcotic cell, Antisexual harassment cell, Counselling Cell, women's forum, National Service Scheme, Youth Red cross society, Career guidance and placement Cell etc. SC/ST monitoring cell functions to ensure the well

being of students belonging to the SC/ST students. The Anti ragging cell with the participation of students and teachers takes measures to prevent ragging and ragging related issues. While anti sexual harassment cell ensures safe environment for girl students at college, the women's cell addresses other issues of the girl students, and counselling helps the students to understand their various issues and guide them to resolve them. Anti narcotic cell named Vimukthi, National Service Scheme and Youth Red cross society are the bodies through which the students through various means serve the society in a committed and responsible way. The students devotedly organize and execute various programmes in connection with national and international days such as environment day, human rights day, AIDS day etc.

6.1.1

Our college is named after the legendary seer Jagadguru Adi Sankaracharya who was a towering personality with scientific outlook. He strived to master the universe through acquisition of knowledge (jnana) which is the passage for realisation of supreme reality. Sankara throughout his life struggled to comprehend the Upanishad Mantra (in sanskrit) "Thamaso ma Jyothirgamaya" (Lead me from the darkness of ignorance to the Light of knowledge) and we consider this as motto.

To update society with modern technological innovations and provide knowledge and personnel for developmental needs. To cater to the educational needs of a wide variety of students coming from various streams of the society especially downtrodden. Being an institution, brought up by a community of Kerala Brahmins, who gave birth to the inimitable visionary, Adi Sankara, it was quite natural that we have formulated our first mission statement viz. "To propagate Value Education based on Vedic culture and to inculcate National Heritage to the student community and ultimately to the society as a whole". We have an organisation, named Sree Sankara Cultural Study Centre which seeks to fulfil this vision. The location of our institution, in a remote rural village of Ernakulum District, led to the development of another mission statement viz. "To cater to the educational needs of a wide variety of students coming from various streams of the society especially downtrodden". The statistics of admission, which shows that the majority of the students are economically and socially marginalised, substantiate the fulfilment of this mission. And finally, we are helping the society with knowledge and personnel for developmental needs.

The college is governed by the Sree Sankara Trust. The Management, Principal, Staff Council, IQAC and faculty members along with other stakeholders work together to strengthen and fulfil institutional Vision and Mission. The shared governance aims to establish, uphold and communicate the vision, mission and the core values. The Principal is advised by the Managing

Committee and supported by internal academic bodies and staff council. Management designs strategic plans with the inputs of IQAC, Planning forum and other stakeholders. The departments prepare the Action plan based on the guidelines given by IQAC to provide quality education, ensure job opportunity and effective support services for the students. HODs are responsible for initiating and implementing policy decisions within the department in tandem with the stated college mission. Staff meetings are conducted regularly which helps in the academic growth and progress. Association activities, seminars, workshops, conferences, and innovative teaching methods are practiced in the departments. NSS, Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Cell, SC/ST Monitoring cell, Internal Complaint cell, Counselling Centre, Grievance and various other cells and clubs also function with operational autonomy.

As part of the institutional decision-making process, faculty has the opportunity to design learning tools and conduct of internal assessment within the framework of teaching plan. The faculty members coordinate and supervise the involvements of students in various extra and co-curricular activities and also promote research culture. 6.5.1

- Organised a Lockdown Survey to understand the problems and prospects of online teaching and learning.
- Organised a One-week FDP on G Suite for Education from 27 th May 2020 With sparse
 physical classroom engagements, many institutions have migrated to the online mode. In
 these circumstances the need for training and quick adaptation of suitable methods is
 critical. The aim of the programme was to help academicians to gather the requisite skills
 to be able to plan, design, and deliver their courses online.
- A video -tutorial and online training for students was launched on June 1 st 2020, regarding how to make use of online platforms for learning. Based on thelockdown survey it was identified that the students faced various problems regarding online class. Many students were not having facility to attend class in online mode. To resolve the issue with online class, more recorded classes were provided. Teachers also uploaded recorded class in YouTube. Also, on the recommendation of IQAC the PTA of the college purchased mobile phones and distributed to financially backward students.
- Organised a National Webinar on "The implementation of NEP, Prospects and Problems on August 22 nd, 2020.

- Technical support was provided to all to departments for organising online courses and programmes in collaboration with PG Department of Computer Science.
- An Online Introductory Course on Open-Source Tools for Instructional Scaffolding was organised on continuous basis in collaboration with PG Department of Computer Science. 315 participants were successfully certified under this programme
- An Online Short Term Course on "Extrapolations through the Extraordinary:
- Broadening Perspective on Magic and Magicality" was organised in association with MG University and in academic collaboration with International Society for Folk Narrative Research from 14 th to 18 th December 2020.
