10th August 2019

One Day workshop on 'Entrepreneurship and Innovation as Career Opportunity.'

Institutional Innovation Council, Sree Sankara Vidyapeetom College in association with Entrepreneurship development club organised one day workshop on 'Entrepreneurship and Innovation as Career Opportunity'. The objective of this programme was to increase the entrepreneurial skill and knowledge and to make the students aware of the different start-up ideas and the various ways to raise finance for investment. The workshop was lead by Varun P Nair.CEO, Infiniz IT Solutions, Kochi. The workshop consists of two sessions. The first session dealt with the importance of entrepreneurship development. The theme of the workshop mainly focused on the scope and importance of undertaking investments for future generations. The students were provided with several study materials. The number of participants was 30.

The second session dealt with the vast career opportunities open to the students to enter in to. It was an activity-oriented session in which 30 students and 12 faculty members participated. Activities are conducted in groups and for this the students were divided into different groups on the basis of their area of interest. Theme based group discussions were conducted to innovate new investment ideas of students and they were asked to present it. Counselling was also given to the students to direct them in choosing their career.

24th August 2019 to 25th August 2019

Field Visit to Ambadimala Water Supply Project of Chottanikkara Panchayath, Ernakulum

Introduction

The students and faculties of IIC of Sree Sankara Vidyapeetom College made a visit to the Ambadimala area of Chottanikkara Panchayath to interact with the residents of the area and to study the project envisaged by Cochin Shipyard Limited to solve the water scarcity problem faced by the households in that area. The visit was done for two days from 24th August 2019 to 25th August 2019. The team of 25 students and 3 faculties participated in the survey and study of the project.

Background

The 750 families residing in Ambadimala settlement colony falling within the Chottanikkara Gram Panchayat were not having proper water supply due to the geographical constraints. The water supply by the water authority was not sufficient to meet the needs. The residents faced the water scarcity problem more in summer season. The residents and the local governing body tried to solve this issue and later they approached the Cochin Shipyard Limited seeking, which is a leading Public Sector Undertaking situated in Cochin. This company offered to help the residents as a part of their Corporate Social Responsibility initiative. They offered the assistance in the form of a drinking water supply project. Major works of the project included a well construction (water source), overhead tank (1,00,000 litre) pipe lines, pumping house, water purification plant and distribution points.

The inauguration of the scheme was held at the site on 27th February, 2016. Shri Madhu S Nair, C&MD, CSL dedicated the scheme and handed over the key to the Grama Panchayat. Shri Anoop Jacob, Honourable Civil Supplies and Education Minister, Govt. of Kerala inaugurated the function in the presence of the officials of Cochin Shipyard, government of Kerala and the residents.

Details of the visit

25 students and 3 faculties visited the area for two days and interacted with residents. They revealed their problems before the implementation of the project and how they were benefitted after this project. The students visited the site of the project.



The project is a real life example of how corporate or business can provide assistance to the society and community where they operate. The students also discussed the benefit of social entrepreneurship.



The company made investment in the project and they handed over the control and management of the project to the Panchayath and the local residents. The project is functioning effectively for the last 3 years. The students have learnt the example of linking social responsibility and entrepreneurship from this field visit.

5th and 6th August 2019: Onam Fair 2019

The entrepreneurship development club of the college was organising Onam fair for the last 3 years. This year the IIC also joined hands with EDC in organising the fair. The students always participate in the fair with great enthusiasm. The club provided platform for all the Associations to put their stalls in the Fair and students put in their creative efforts and made the Fair a grand success.



Palakkad Khadi Sarvodaya Sangham and nearby textiles put their stalls in the fair. Apart from that the National Service Scheme of the College had also put a stall of organic vegetables they cultivated in the college premises. The fair was a great success because of the huge participation of the faculty members and students. 285 students participated in the fair

One Day Field Visit to MILMA Date: 27th November 2019 (Thursday) Venue: MILMA, Edappally Details of the Programme

Ernakulam Regional Co-operative Milk Producers' Union Ltd (ERCMPU) - milma Ernakulam Region was established in 1985. ERCMPU operates under the three tier - "Anand Pattern" - covering about 980 village level dairy co-operative societies spread across the four central districts of Kerala. The Union channelizes marketable surplus from the rural areas to urban deficit areas to provide assured year round market and maximize return to milk producers while providing quality milk and milk products to the consumers.



Three faculties and 40 students visited the Milma plant at Edappally, Ernakulam and understood the operations. They were explained about the production, distribution and marketing of different milk products offered by MILMA. The students were shown the operations of the plant, how their distribution network works and how they market the products. Success story of MILMA over the years were shared with the students.

The 'National Student and Faculty Start-up policy 2019' is a guiding framework to envision an educational system oriented towards start ups and entrepreneurship opportunities for student and faculties. The guidelines provide ways to Indian HEIs for developing entrepreneurial agenda, managing Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) ownership, technology licensing and equity sharing in Start-ups or enterprises established by faculty and students.


Online Session on Role of Network Enablers in driving I&E in HEIs - A Case of TiE, India on 1st May 2020


Online Session on "Entrepreneurship, Business Idea, and Business Model Canvas" on 5th May, 2020


Online Session on "How to identify right problems and solutions using the double diamond approach in design" on 6th May, 2020


Online Session on Intellectual Property (IP) Management at Early Stage of Innovation and Start-ups on 7th May, 2020

That's where the angel networks and venture capital funds come in. They usually fund up to 3 crores.


IIC Session on Use Of Market Data And Application Of Marketing Research Tools And Methodology on 20th May, 2020

The major areas of discussion were Use of market Data and Market research tool for start-ups. Market research simply tells about who is going to buy your product. Market research is continuous. It also includes what customers' think about that product, what they feel and what their needs are. Topics related to market research, need for research and segmentation, targeting, positioning (STP) were discussed in detail.



Online Session on Frugal innovation & Social Entrepreneurship on 21st May, 2020

An online session on the topic, Frugal innovation & social entrepreneurship, was organised by IIC-MHRD on 21st May, 2020. The speaker for the session was Dr. Raman Gujral, Professor, EDII. The session was attended by the students of Sree Sankara Vidyapeetom College on Youtube. Dr.Gujral said that creativity is a skill and innovation is a process. Innovation involves thinking differently and creatively. He told that innovation enables solution that has an impact on social and economic value. For innovation there should be some idea factors such as need and solution spotting. He discussed that for innovation we should keep three things in mind - what is desirable to users, what is viable in the market place and what is possible with technology. According to him, Innovation is classified into 3 channels, which are Product innovation, Service innovation and Process innovation.

Session II: Start-up Journey Issues and Challenges




Session III: Introduction to Intellectual Property Rights
