Session IV: Role and Relevance of Intellectual Property Rights





The aim of the programme was to give insight to students on the importance of entrepreneurship and innovation in based on the National Education Policy 2020.



# Report on Student participation in Internship Programmes during Semester Break




#### 'From your Ph.D./Master's thesis to a start-up'


Date : 23rd April 2021


## An online Session on "Why IP is important in academia?"








#### **Report on Toycathon**


#### **Paper Presentation Competition**
