

#### 21. Aug 10-15: Flood Relief activities

Kerala is facing a second flood now after the last year's flood. People are less affected in Eranakulam compared with Northern Districts of Kerala.NSS unit of our college actively participated in flood relief activities in Eranakulam and other districts as well. NSS Volunteers (11 Nos.) worked day and night at different camps and at Collection centre ,Collectorate ,Eranakulam from 10-08-2019 to 16-08-19.

22. Aug.10: Started Collection Centre at the College: Under the leadership of NSS Unit no.49, collection centre has been opened at the college. A massive campaigning through social media had resulted in collection of large quantity of articles like Mat, Bed sheets ,Rice and provisions. As per the requirement from Eloor Town ship school, (Where our volunteers serving), we have provided necessary articles with them. The approximate amount of articles supplied at Eloor camp would be Rs.25,110. (Twenty five thousand OneHundred and Ten Rupees Only).

23. Aug.12-14: Collection of Materials at the College: Our unit is planning to visit and distribute relief materials at Nilamboor, the most affected place in the flood and landslide in Malappuram. The collection was made with in association with Keezhillam club and ILM college. All Volunteers (200) participated in the collection drive by contributing at least one material and Rs.20.All staff, Management and students participated along with general public .Various nearby clubs, Alumni associations, Employees from Info park were also contributed in our collection drive. We have received large quantity of materials and these are sorted by volunteers. Collected materials were packed in kit containing 30 essential articles for a family.One kit approximately worth Rs.2000 (Rupees Two thousand only).Our unit prepared 111 such kits and the balance of articles were packed in cartons. Other associated parties have prepared 252 such kits. Packaging and loading of articles in Lorry finished by early 2.00 am on 15-8-19.

As we planned, we could distribute articles directly to the flood affected victims at Munderi, Edakkara, Vellakkettu, Karakkodu villages of Nilamboor and Vazhikkadavu Regions. Programme officer along with six volunteers visited the area and supplied the kits by join hands with our associates. We could spent time till 11 pm with people at Nilamboor. Approximate materials worth Eight lakhs rupees supplied and our NSS units' contribution is Rs.3,05,160/-(Rupees Three Lakh Five Thousand One Hundred and Sixty Only)


