The main challenge of the work ids to bring the materials at the site because ther is only walk way to the home site. So all the volunteers participated in bringing the construction materials at the site as per the time table prepared. The estimate of the house is RS.1,30,000(Rupees One Lakh Thirty Thousand only) excluding the notional cost volunteers. The required amount will be raised by the contribution of all staff and management of the college and the local well-wishers of the family.
