
Feedback Analysis: The IQAC analyzed the feedback, compiling detailed summaries and department-specific reports to guide the college's adaptation to the changing educational landscape.




Suggestions from students




Suggestions from Teachers

- Research culture has to be improved








Suggestions by Alumni
