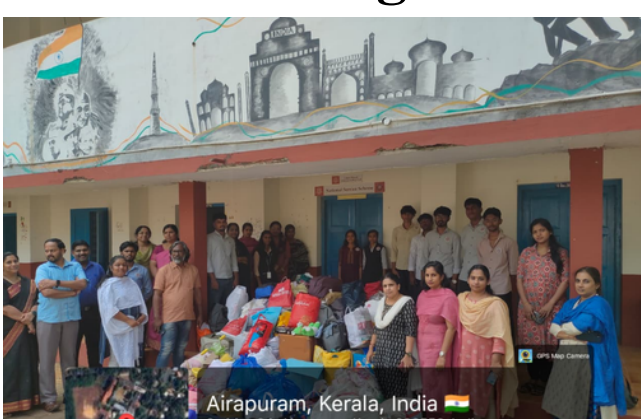
## Green Warriors in Action: SSV College NSS Unit Conducts Mega Plastic Waste Collection Drive

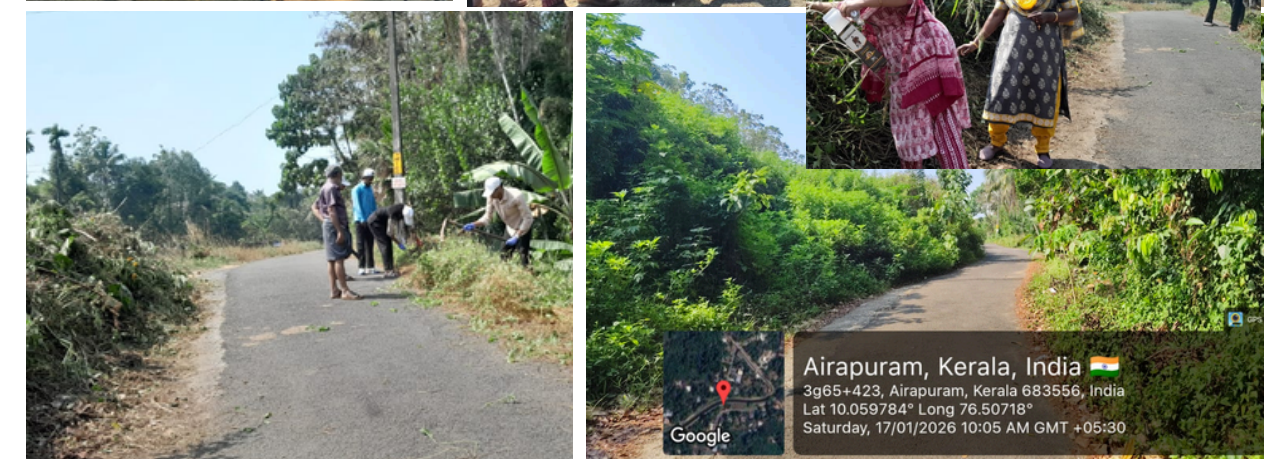

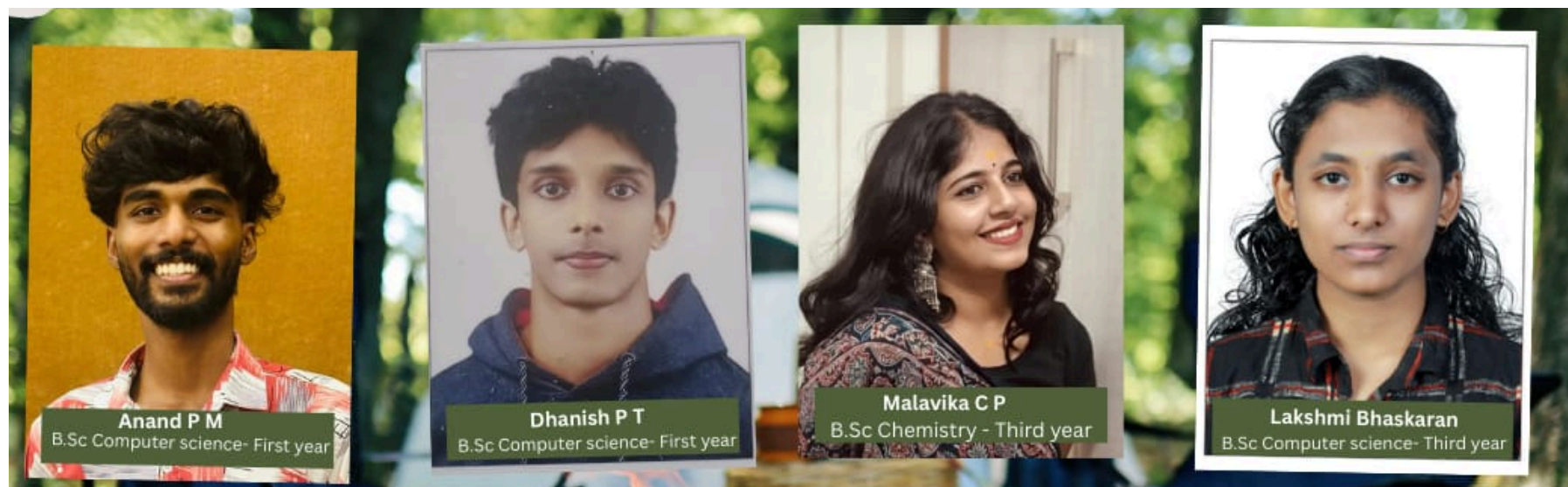
## "Run for Swadeshi" to Mark National Youth Day

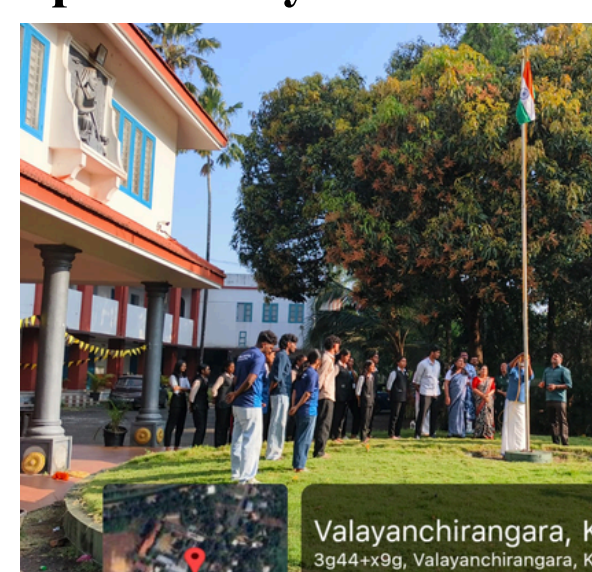
## SSV College NSS Unit Celebrates 77th Republic Day

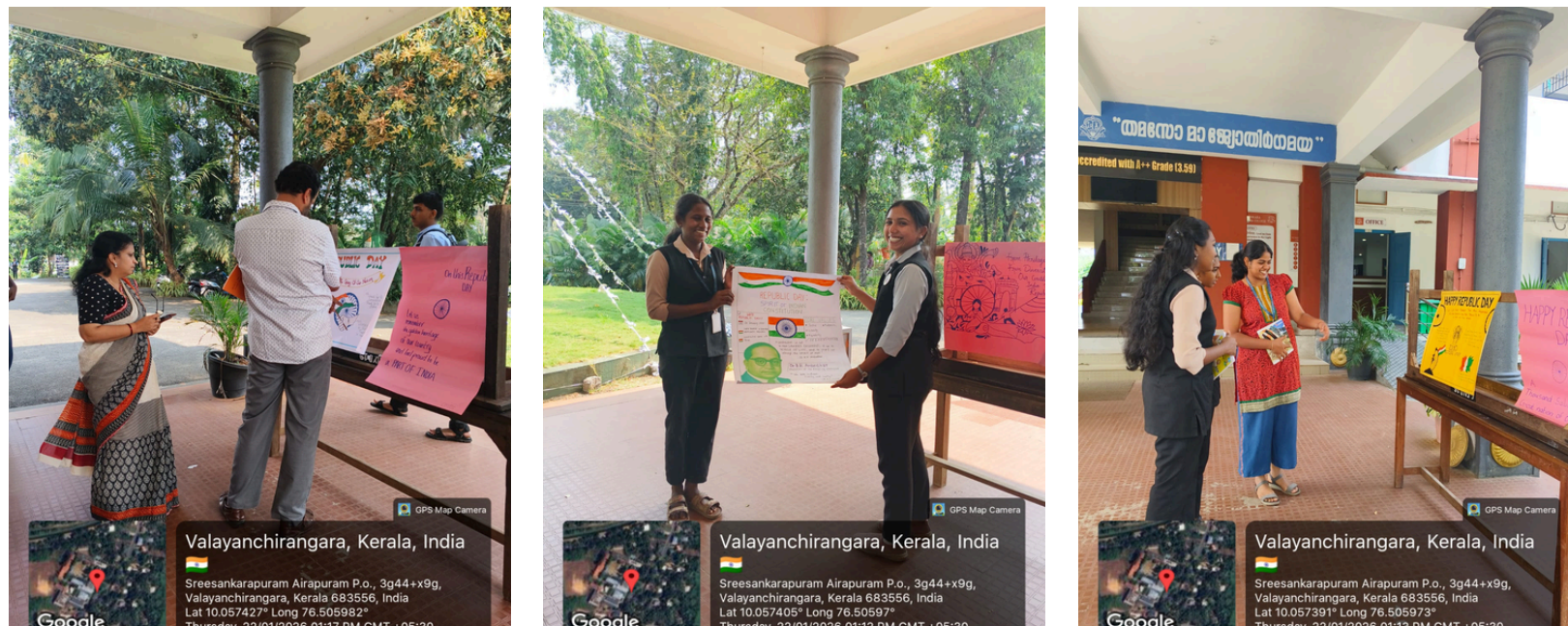

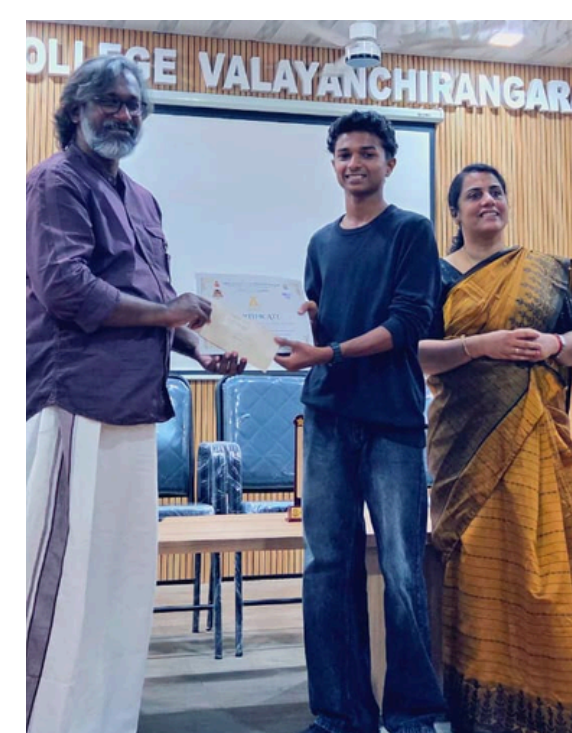
