Action Taken Report for Student Feedback 2023-2024

Overall, the feedback indicates a positive perception of various aspects of the institution. The respondents generally agree or strongly agree with most statements, suggesting a favourable experience. Below is a summary of the feedback received from 403 students on each question:

The feedback suggests that the institution has been successful in creating a clean and hygienic classroom environment, providing adequate library spaces, and offering flexibility for co-curricular activities. Positive aspects also include clarity in the evaluation process, availability of teachers for guidance, and the quality of the laboratory environment. However, there is room for improvement in the tools and techniques used for curriculum delivery, as some respondents remained neutral or disagreed on this aspect.

Overall, the feedback reflects a generally positive experience, emphasizing strengths while also identifying opportunities for further improvement.

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The report highlights the actions taken and their impact on the quality of learning. Please find the details below:

Hygiene Classroom Environment:

- External manpower support from "Trees" is utilised for campus cleaning and beautification.
- Students are encouraged to keep the classrooms clean and to report to the tutor in case of any support required.
- Cleaning and maintenance protocols have been reinforced to ensure a clean and hygienic classroom environment, Senior LD Clerk Vishnu Namboothiri was assigned the charge of monitoring the process.
- Regular inspections and prompt maintenance of facilities have been conducted by a 3 member committee.
- Adequate sanitation facilities, such as handwashing stations and sanitizers, have been provided.

Result: The improved hygiene measures have created a conducive learning environment and positively influenced the overall well-being of students and teachers.

Library Ambience:

- The Library revamping by the management is in progress.
- The PD fund for Additional resources, including a diverse collection of books, digital materials, and online databases, to cater to different learning preferences.

Result: The enhanced library ambience will provide students with ample opportunities for self-directed learning, research, and collaborative activities.

Co-curricular Ambience:

- As the pandemic situation has lightened, many co curricular activities were conducted in the campus.
- The institution has expanded its co-curricular activities and introduced a wider range of clubs, societies, and extracurricular programs.
- Students are encouraged to explore their interests and talents through participation in various events, competitions, and workshops.

Flexible scheduling allows students to balance their academic and co-curricular pursuits effectively.

Result. The co-curricular ambience provides students with the freedom to discover and develop their skills beyond the traditional curriculum, fostering holistic growth and self-exploration.

Clarity in Evaluation Process:

- The general awareness about the evaluation process is added to the student induction programme.
- The evaluation process has been streamlined, and clear guidelines have been communicated to students regarding assessment criteria, grading systems, and evaluation timelines.
- Teachers provide regular feedback on assignments and assessments, enabling students to track their progress and identify areas for improvement.

Result: The improved clarity in the evaluation process has enhanced students' understanding of academic expectations, leading to improved performance and motivation.

Laboratory Environment:

- The accumulated PD fund was utilised in the laboratory facilities for upgrading it with global standards.
- Trained lab technicians and supervisors are available to provide guidance and support during practical sessions.

Result: The improved laboratory environment has facilitated effective learning and better comprehension of scientific concepts through hands-on experimentation.

Availability of Teachers for Discussion and Guidance:

- Teachers have dedicated office hours (generally 03:30 PM to 04:30 PM) to address students' queries and provide additional guidance outside the classroom.
- Regular meetings and counselling sessions are organised to address individual student concerns and provide academic support.

Result: The availability of teachers for discussion and guidance has enhanced the academic performance by offering personalised attention and clarifying doubts.

Support in Compensating Curriculum and ICT Inadequacy:

- The management has sanctioned fund for making all the classrooms ICT enabled and the purchase of smart panels for each departments to utilise the modern tools in the academic selector for effective curriculum implementation
- The value-added courses provided by the departments and those in swayam platform are highly encouraged.
- Teachers actively supplement the information presented in textbooks by incorporating additional resources, such as research articles, case studies, and multimedia content. The Google Classroom is widely used as a platform for this.
- They provide comprehensive explanations and practical examples to bridge any gaps in the textbook content.

Result: The supportive approach of the institution in compensating the inadequacy of the curriculum and ICT has enriched students' understanding and expanded their knowledge base.

Action Taken Report for Faculty Feedback 2023-2024
