The IQAC initiates these activities and creates an action plan accordingly for overcoming the weakness and utilising the areas of improvement. Our system is designed to be flexible and accessible, encouraging stakeholders to share their insights through various means, including our ERP software and Google Forms. This process reflects our commitment to maintaining the highest standards in education and campus life, adapting to the evolving needs and preferences of our college community.

Feedback Mechanism

Feedback collection: At Sree Sankara Vidyapeetom College, we prioritise gathering feedback on our Curriculum and Academic Environment from a diverse group of stakeholders, including students, alumni, faculty, and employers. This is a key part of our quality enhancement initiative, overseen by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC). Annually, a dedicated team is tasked with creating a comprehensive questionnaire. Unlike the typical 5-point rating scale, our questionnaire incorporates a variety of response formats, including multiple-choice, yes/no questions, and qualitative inputs, to gain a more nuanced understanding of stakeholder perspectives. The questionnaire is regularly reviewed and updated to reflect evolving needs and is approved by the IQAC before being distributed for feedback collection. Stakeholders can provide their responses either through traditional offline methods or online via platforms like Google Forms.

Feedback Analysis: The IQAC plays a crucial role in analysing the feedback collected from different stakeholders. The team compiles an overarching feedback summary and also creates department-specific reports. These reports are crucial for understanding the unique needs and suggestions of each department.



Student Feedback Analysis Report 2022-2023



2. Library ambience provides enough informal learning spaces. 402 responses




A significant portion of the students agrees that the library ambience offers sufficient informal learning spaces, while a quarter remains neutral on the statement.




3. Co-curricular ambience of the institution gives enough flexibility for students to explore themselves.


Even Though the majority agrees that the co-curricular ambience of the institution allows students to explore themselves adequately, a small percentage is neutral or disagrees.

4. Clarity in the rules of evaluation process improved the academic performance 402 responses




The majority agrees that clear rules in the evaluation process have a positive impact on academic performance.

The majority of the students agree that the laboratory environment facilitates effective learning and understanding of experiments.


6. Availability of teachers for discussion and guidance improves the academic performance 402 responses




The majority is happy with the way the portions are covered in the classroom.

Even Though the majority is happy with the curriculum introduction, a very small portion needs improvement.


11. How effectively the curriculum for the program was implemented? 402 responses



The majority is happy with the way the curriculum was implemented.


12. How do you rate the open courses provided in our institution? Applicable only to third year degree students


Even Though the majority is happy with the open courses provided, a very small portion needs improvement.

13. Was there promptness in the conduct of internal assessments? 402 responses




The majority agrees to the promptness in internal assessments.

The majority agrees to the transparency in assessment evaluation.


15. Were the results of internal assessments properly published? 402 responses

Overall, the feedback suggests a generally positive experience, highlighting areas of strength as well as opportunities for further enhancement.




Faculty Feedback Analysis Report 2022-2023



1. Classroom ambience is suitable for effective supervision and control of the class. 48 responses




2. Campus environment promotes healthy interaction of teachers with students. 48 responses






3. The curriculum opens informal learning atmosphere in $\frac{1}{2}$ terms of field visits and projects . 48 responses




5. The infrastructure is inclusive to meet the needs of differently-abled stakeholder fraternity 48 responses






6. College library bridges the gaps in teaching learning process.




Alumni Feedback Analysis Report 2022-2023

Based on the responses received from 121 alumni, the following are the key findings based on our questions:


1. Academic atmosphere shaped the character in terms of values and creative attitudes.






5. The outreach activities inculcated social competence and personal growth ²⁷ responses




6. Student-teacher relationship is positive and active with mutual respect

Employer Feedback Analysis Report 2022-2023
