PROGRAMME REPORT

The seminar aimed to educate participants with a comprehensive understanding of the concept of social entrepreneurship, including key concepts, principles, and best practices. 58 students and 5 faculty members attended the session. Mr. Justin Joseph, a trainer at Infiniz IT Solutions, Kochi was the resource person.

The first session covered the basics of entrepreneurship and the resource person gave an overview of the objectives of the seminar. The second session began with an exploration of the concept of social entrepreneurship, emphasizing its distinct features, such as a focus on social or environmental impact alongside financial sustainability. In the next sessions, Mr. Justin Joseph discussed the strategies required for the planning of a business venture including developing and drafting of business model canvas. He also discussed the financial planning, budgeting and funding options available for startups.

The resource person showcased successful social entrepreneurship ventures and their transformative impact on communities. The final session was on the marketing strategies that startups can adopt to assure market presence to promote their products and services. The technical session was followed by an interactive Q&A session for 30 minutes. The session allowed participants to ask questions and get clarification on various aspects of entrepreneurship. The interactive session was really helpful in addressing the queries and doubts of the attendees related to entrepreneurship.
