PROGRAMME REPORT

The Department of Commerce organized a seminar on climate change: Scientific temper as a key as part of observance of world conservation day. Mr. Bharath Govind G.S, co-founder & CEO, Climate Hood foundation and 2021 climate Ambassador of India Global Youth Climate Network (Y2Y), World bank group.

The seminar aimed to provide students an understanding of the science behind climate change and for promoting a scientific approach to address environmental changes. The resource person emphasized the importance of scientific temper in addressing climate change. He has also discussed the actions needed by 2030 for getting to net-zero carbon emissions by 2050.

The resource person suggested increased investments in renewable energy sources such as solar, wind, hydro, and geothermal can be accelerated by Government subsidies and tax breaks. He emphasized the development and implementation of plans to phase out the use of fossil fuels in power generation, transportation, and industry.

In the last session, he discussed the importance of scientific temper and research in solving the climate crisis and also to attain zero carbon emission. He also explained the various opportunities available for students in the area of carbon capture, storage and utilization. The seminar helped in the reinforcement of the role of scientific temper in combating climate change among the participants.






Figure 2 Screenshots of the seminar
