PROGRAMME REPORT

The seminar on Business Model Canvas as part of IIC session organized by the Institution Innovation Council of S.S.V College was conducted on 31-08-2022 from 10.00 a.m. to 11.30 a.m. in Google meet platform. The session was handled by Mr. Aby Varghese, Convenor, Makerhub Amal Jyothi IEDC.

The primary goal of the seminar was to identify and emphasize the importance of the Business Model Canvas (BMC) in the process of setting up a startup. Participants were guided through practical exercises and discussions to understand how the BMC serves as a strategic tool for developing, describing, and visualizing a startup's business model.

The session started with the resource person explaining the basic concepts of business model canvas and its significance in startup development. He then explained the nine building blocks of BMC and the success story of his own success story. Participants were divided into groups and were provided with a hypothetical startup scenario. The groups were assisted by the resource person for the filling up of various blocks of BMC corresponding to their startup ideas.

The resource person briefed the participants about the various blocks to be filled in developing the business model canvas. The session was supplemented with the resource person's personal experiences which helped the participants to better understand the concept and need of a business model canvas. The resource person also explained the use of BMC as visual aid during business pitches. He has also given tips for effectively communicating the business model canvas to potential investors.

The seminar successfully achieved its objective by providing participants with a comprehensive understanding of the Business Model Canvas and its application in setting up a startup. The interactive and hands-on nature of the seminar ensured a practical and engaging learning experience for all participants.
