## "Vision for a Brighter Tomorrow": Ophthalmology Camp




**Ophthalmology Camp on November 1, 2022**




## Medical Camp for assessing lifestyle diseases

#### Community Awareness Programme - "Mental health in Young People"




Community Awareness Program on Anti-Tobacco Day on May 31, 2022

## **Blood Donation Camp in Association with District Hospital Aluva**




Blood donation camp on July 26, 2018
